Visiting Niagara Falls

Niagara Falls consist of three sections. The large Canadian Falls – with its distinctive curved shape – is also known as the Horseshoe Falls. The Canadian Falls are separated by Goat Island from the American Falls, which is separated by a small island at its south end from the narrow Bridal Veil Falls.

Each side of the Falls offers a different perspective, and it is always best to visit both sides to maximize your experience.

The American side gives a side-on view of the American Falls, and an observation point only 20 yards from the top of the Falls.

Although the Canadian side is touted for having the best view, the American side is located within the oldest state park in the nation, so efforts have been made to preserve the natural beauty of the area and prevent the kind of commercialization that you'll find on the Canadian side. Visitors looking to experience the Falls as a natural wonder will appreciate this.

Views of Niagara Falls are free and accessible. Access to the riverside walks and parks offer great views. You can walk across to Goat Island on the pedestrian bridge.





Visiting Niagara Falls

There are a number of attractions designed to enjoy the Falls.

Cave of the Winds – An elevator takes you down to a walkway that leads you right to the bottom of the Bridal Veil Falls. You will definitely get a feel for the true power of the Falls! This is the closest you can get to the Falls on either side without actually leaping into them! Open year round. www.niagarafallsstatepark.com

Maid of the Mist – A boat ride taking you down around the bottom of the Falls. An unforgettable experience is looking up at the Falls from below and feeling the mist coming off the Falls (hence the name). Seasonal. www.maidofthemist.com

Aquarium of Niagara – A world of discovery with over 1,500 aquatic animals. Sharks, piranhas, sea lions, sea horses, giant Pacific octopus and a colony of Peruvian penguins. Open year round. www.aquariumofniagara.org

Niagara Scenic Trolley – Use this to get around the park more quickly if needed. \$2 adults/\$1 children for the entire day. Hop on and off.

Discover Niagara Shuttle – Experience Niagara's iconic landscape, rich history and the thriving culture and communities with the ease and convenience of a complimentary hop-on/hop-off shuttle. Seasonal. www.discoverniagarashuttle.com

Whirlpool Jet Boat Tours – In nearby Lewiston is a jet boat ride that will take you up the Niagara river towards the whirlpool. www.whirlpooljet.com

Beyond The Falls

Old Fort Niagara – A fortification originally built to protect the interests of New France in North America. It is located near Youngstown, New York, on the eastern bank of the Niagara River at its mouth, on Lake Ontario. Open all year round. www.oldfortniagara.org

Historic Lewiston – Located just ten minutes north of Niagara Falls, Lewiston rests along the banks of the Niagara River. It is known for unique festivals, quaint charm, rich history and outstanding fishing. Center Street is famous for boutique shops and outstanding restaurants. www.niagarariverregion.com

Ransomville – Rich in agro-tourism opportunities, Ransomville is known for orchards and farm markets. Roadside farm stands will tempt you with their fresh homegrown produce including some of the tastiest apples anywhere in the US.

Niagara County Wine Trail – Nestled between the famous Niagara Escarpment and Lake Ontario, The Niagara Wine Trail features a beautiful combination of wineries and serene farm vistas, and a truly rural life. www.niagarawinetrail.org

Our Lady of Fatima Shrine – Located near Lewiston, it is a place of natural beauty, art, communal prayer and renewal to the thousands who visit the chapels and spiritual grounds each year. The Avenue of Saints features more than one hundred life-size marble statues representing Saints from every race and walk of life. www.fatimashrine.com

Buffalo & Erie County Naval & Military Park – The largest inland Naval Park in the country. Located on Buffalo's Waterfront, this unique family destination features four decommissioned Naval vessels that served in a variety of military conflicts in our nation's history. buffalonaivalpark.org

Darwin Martin House – Designed by Frank Lloyd Wright and built between 1903 and 1905. Located at 125 Jewett Parkway in Buffalo, New York, it is considered to be one of the most important projects from Wright's Prairie School era, and ranks along with The Guggenheim in New York City and Fallingwater in Pennsylvania among his greatest works. www.darwinmartinhouse.org

The Buffalo Zoo – Founded in 1875, The Buffalo Zoo is the third oldest zoo in the United States. Each year, the Zoo welcomes approximately 400,000 visitors and is the second largest tourist attraction in Western New York, second only to Niagara Falls. Located on 23.5 acres of Buffalo's beautiful Delaware Park, the Zoo exhibits a diverse collection of wild and exotic animals and more than 320 different species of plants. www.buffalozoo.org

Olcott – Perched on the shores of Lake Ontario is Olcott, a waterfront town that feels like a step back in time. Swimming beach, ice cream shops, restaurants, fishing pier, boardwalk, Olcott Beach Lighthouse and the Olcott Beach Carousel Park a vintage kiddy park.
